Fort Halifax Park Rules and Regulations

Regulations for Park visitors are based on respect for others and the environment. The way you would like to have yourself and your property treated is the way that you should treat other Park users, plants, animals and Park property..

Hours

The Park is open from dawn to dusk. except for fisherman who may fish during hours of darkness.

Overnight Camping

Overnight camping is allowed at designated sites by permit.*

Large Groups

Organized groups may use the Park when authorized by Halifax Township. Authorization is required for groups of 10 or more persons.*

Fires

Campfires are permitted in fire rings provided except when weather conditions create a fire hazard. Fires should be extinguished before leaving the Park.

Refuse

Park users shall not leave any refuse and shall deposit trash in receptacles provided or take it home with them.

Parking

Overnight parking is not allowed except for permitted campers* and anglers.

Motor Vehicles

Operation of motor vehicles is prohibited except when authorized. The speed limit within the Park is 10 mph.

Pets

Dogs are permitted but must be leashed. Clean up after your pet.

Alcohol

The use, sale or possession of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.

Wildlife

The Park is a safe haven for all forms of wildlife. The use of snares, traps, poisons, or the disturbance of wildlife is forbidden.

Natural Resources

The use of metal detectors on Park land is not permitted. It is unlawful to remove any artifact, excavate, or cause any ground disturbance.
